

# **Growing Season**

The amazing Napa wine conditions continue. As much as 2015 mimicked 2013, 2016 mimics 2014. Harvest occurred in September with a continuation of low yield that dates back to the 2013 vintage. The drought conditions towards the maturation phase of berry development gave us small concentrated clusters of grapes; perfect for making intense and concentrated aromatic wines albeit in limited quantities. Expect good quality, ruby color and the potential for some great structured, extracted wine.

#### Artist

Barrel Regime: 18 months in 100% new French oak. Natural malolactic fermentation.

Bottled unfined and unfiltered. **RRP:** \$75 per 750ml bottle

### **Tasting Notes**

Color; Lighter than previous vintages, tanzanite red flicker to thin edge. Nose; New French Oak / Cherry / Strawberry. Alcohol is very subtle for a full-bodied Napa Cab that is this young. Palate; Smooth velvety tannins, cherry and passion fruit. Nice acidity. Much more approachable than previous vintages. Drink; Do your best and try to give it a at least 6 months after bottling. Winter 2019-2029 - Expected release is Oct/Nov. \*Decanted for 2hrs, examined again after 24hrs open time. Topped with blue wax. -Robin Akhurst & Brian Schmaltz (July 28th 2018)
