Growing Season

We shall rebuild. In the wake of the 2017 season, 2018 was off to a wonderful start. February saw abundant rains. Both bud break and flowering occurred a bit late, but under ideal weather conditions, creating plentiful and even fruit set. Summer brought generous sun during the day and cooler marine influences, virtually uninterrupted by major heat spikes. The relatively mild summer followed by extended fall sunshine and moderate heat created near-ideal conditions for winemakers to allow their fruit to accumulate flavor complexity with gradual increases in sugar levels. 2018 mimics that of 2012, good quantity of high-quality fruit. With the extended growing season, we saw serious potential for some great structured wine.

Nice acidity. <u>Drink</u>; Do your best and try to give it at least 6 months after bottling. Winter 2020-2035 - Expected release May. *Decanted for 2hrs, examined again after 24hrs open time.
